- Reading.



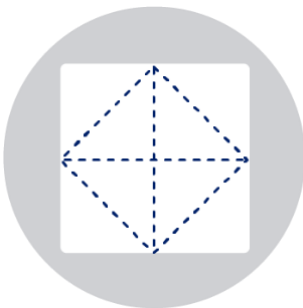
Ellie has been playing the ukulele for five years.

Ellie loves to make origami sculptures.



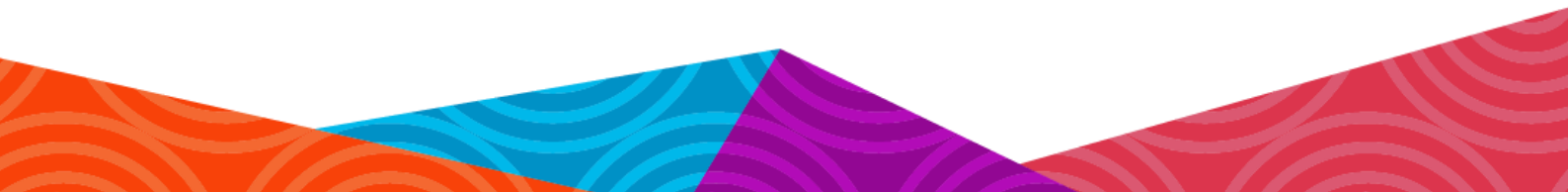
Origami sculptures are made by folding pieces of paper together.
