# ADS Advisory Council – 2025 Work Plan: Council Outcomes and Areas for Advice

The 2025 Work Plan provides a public record of key areas the Council plans to provide advice on in 2025, summarised into the following high- level agendas spanning the four meetings scheduled for 2025. This Work Plan sets out key items where the Council intends to explore a topic in depth prior to providing advice.

Note: Timings for items including cross-portfolio topics (e.g. Housing, Aviation, First Nations) and the ADS Evaluation are pending confirmation, and may result in changes to the high-level agendas proposed below. The scheduling may change further dependent on the priorities of the Council.

## Council Meeting 1: 13 March 2025

- Evaluation in ADS Phase One: (the Guide to Involving People with Disability in Evaluation)
  - Council to agree on informal advice on the Evaluation and Guide to Involving People with Disability in Evaluation, and how it should be developed/scope/content, demonstrating Council's understanding of how the Guide will support the Evaluation project.
- Reporting on the next set of Targeted Action Plans Phase One
  - Council to agree on formal advice for DRMC on what a good 'TAP report' would look like, and how reporting accounts for disability diversity and intersectionality.

## Council Meeting 2: [2 day face to face] 17 and 18 June 2025

- The development of the proposed new ADS Community Engagement plan, in response to a key recommendation of the recent ADS Review Report
  - Council to agree on informal advice on the development/scope/intent of the Engagement plan.
- ADS data and research mechanisms, including the National Disability Data Asset (NDDA), the National Disability Research Partnership (NDRP) and the ADS Outcomes Framework and associated data improvement work
  - Day 1 (17 June) Deep Dive: Information for Council to support understanding of ADS data improvement, linkages with NDDA and NDRP and opportunities to shape related work.
  - Day 2 (18 June) Council to agree initial observations on how NDDA and NDRP operate in alignment with ADS. May include joint discussion with NDDA Council and/or NDRP representatives.

### Council Meeting 3: 28 August 2025

- Reporting on the next set of Targeted Action Plans Phase Two
  - Council to agree on formal advice to DRMC on how TAP reporting meets the expectations set out in Phase One.
- The proposed new Associated Plan on Accessible Information and Communications and relevant activities, in response to DRC Recommendation 6.1 and 6.2
  - Council to agree on informal advice on the work being undertaken on the development of the Accessible Communications Associated Plan.

### **Council Meeting 4: 20 November 2025**

- The Government's proposals to improve community attitudes and understanding of disability
  - Council to agree on informal advice on proposed approach to improve community attitudes and understanding of disability.
- How ADS is being implemented across portfolios
  - Council to agree on formal advice to DRMC on how it sees ADS is being implemented through the Housing portfolio, as a first step to improve crossportfolio oversight of ADS.
- 2026 Work Plan approval
  - Council to agree on the 2026 Work Plan for the Council, which will then be taken to DRMC for agreement.
- ADS Advisory Council Draft 2026 ToR update
  - Council to agree on the 2026 ToR Update, which will then be taken to DRMC for agreement.
